



August 2018 Urban Landscape Report



New Plantings & Features

There were no new plantings or landscape installations in August. Special attention was given to catching up on routine maintenance such as new tree watering, weed and fire ant control.

Tree Pruning & Landscape Maintenance

August was a big month for tree pruning. All trees around the Community Park Little League fields were pruned, chipped, fertilized, and mulched. All trees around the Independence Park parking area and boat launch were pruned, chipped, fertilized, and mulched. All trees at Quail Valley North Park were pruned and chipped. The Forestry crew also helped with installing new sod at Quail Valley North Park. All trees along the Cartwright Road medians were lightly pruned and weeds sprayed. Minor pruning and storm damage pruning was conducted on various trees at Ridgeview Park, Mosley Park & Sta-Mo Park. Finally, pruning & weed control work was started at MacNaughton Park and Oyster Creek Trail.
